Please be advised that Deputy Constable Janie McCown has accepted a full time position with the Constable Gene DeForest office for Pct 2.

Deputy McCown is being replaced by a recently retired Deputy Sheriff with 23 years experience with the Sheriff's Department. The new deputy constable will begin riding with Deputy Constable McCown on Monday, February 9, 2009. I will keep you advised as this new deputy takes over the responsibility of the patrol.

Those of you present at the last annual meeting of the MTPOA may remember when Constable Gene DeForest asked how many residents are willing to pay \$ 10.00 per month extra for a 40 hour per week patrol that virtually 95% of those present raised their hands.

* Agency Assist is when the deputy constable on patrol leaves the area to assist another police agency. Most common would be an assist for the Sheriff's department. This is at the discretion of the deputy on patrol. It may be a simple matter such as checking an residential alarm in a area close by or assisting in a very complicated manner.

The category Extra patrols normally represent vacation watches. All residents of Montgomery Trace have available an opportunity to go online at www.montgomerytracepoa.com and complete a confidential vacation watch form and once it is submitted the only recipient is Captain White at the Pct. 2 Constables office. Captain White informs the deputy on patrol of the request and each time the deputy constable is on patrol he checks the residence to ensure all is well. If there are any problems found by the deputy constable he is able to notify the home owner using the contact information provided in the vacation watch form.

There is no minimum number of vacation days required for the vacation watch to be activated. It can be for just a weekend.
