

Stage 1 Voluntary Water Restrictions

Texas is continuing to experience widespread drought conditions which are expected to intensify and last throughout the next several months. The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) is strongly encouraging systems statewide to implement their drought contingency plans.

At this time, Quadvest is implementing a Voluntary Water Use Restriction. We want to take every step possible to make sure we can supply everyone with adequate and uninterrupted service during the months to come.

To achieve this goal, we are placing your water system on Voluntary Water Use Restrictions. Until further notice, your subdivision is immediately, upon receipt of this notice, on Stage 1 Water Restrictions and will remain on Stage 1 until we notify you that the restrictions have been cancelled or Stage 2 goes into effect.

Water customers are requested to voluntarily limit the irrigation of landscaped areas to Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Saturdays for customers with a street address ending in an even number (0, 2, 4, 6 or 8), and Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays for water customers with a street address ending in an odd number (1, 3, 5, 7 or 9). Irrigation of landscapes should only be between the hours of midnight and 10:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. to midnight on these designated watering days.

Water customers are requested to practice water conservation and to minimize or discontinue non-essential water use. No irrigation of landscaped areas on Sunday.

Thank you for your cooperation in helping us these demands. These actions will help in the preservation of this precious resource.
